How to Write a Test Question:

NRRTS requires 5 test questions for each 1 hour webinar. These can be True/False or Multiple Choice. Multiple Choice questions must have 4 possible answers of which one is correct. The correct answer can be “all of the above.”

Please include an answer key. Make sure that you address this information within your presentation.

Each Learning Outcome must be addressed by at least one test question. Not every test question has to address a Learning Outcome, however.

The participants do not have an opportunity to study your material. The participant should not be able to pass the post-test without attending the webinar, but the participant should be able to pass the post-test after only listening to you present the material one time.

It is important to make the questions clear. Avoid asking a negative question, such as “Which of these is not appropriate to use when a client has a kyphosis?” Make sure only one answer is clearly the correct one.

Most participants miss a post-test question because the question and answers are not well written or because the speaker did not adequately cover that portion of the material. Try to **bold** information in your PowerPoint that is covered by a test question to remind you to address this content.
