Who

All NRRTS RRTS[™] Registrants; former NRRTS Registrants and other RTSs in the field

What

NRRTS wants to recognize your accomplishments and experience by creating a temporary, accelerated program for receiving your CRTS[®], Certified Rehabilitation Technology Supplier[®], credential.

Why

NRRTS has been providing credentials to rehabilitation technology suppliers for 17 years, longer than any organization in the Complex Rehab industry and profession. The CRTS[®] credential has been included by CMS in its supplier and accreditation standards and NRRTS is working to assure that the CRTS[®] credential is recognized as we move forward toward a separate Complex Rehab Benefit Category under Medicare.

When

The CRTS[®] Amnesty Program will run from January 15 – February 28, 2010 but NRRTS will begin accepting applications for consideration under the program starting immediately.

Recognizing your experience and accomplishments

Qualification/requirements

- To be awarded the CRTS[®] credential under this program you must:
 - Have been an ATS (now called ATP – Assistant Technology Professional) for at least the 36 months immediately prior to applying for NRRTS Registration under the amnesty program
 - Have been continually employed by a Complex Rehab company as an RTS for at least the 36 months immediately prior to applying for NRRTS Registration under the amnesty program. Employment as a manufacturer's representative, clinical therapist, etc., does not qualify under the employment requirement.
 - Meet the registration requirements listed in the NRRTS Application Registration Requirement.
 - Submit a completed NRRTS Registration application along with the \$25 non-refundable application fee and a copy of your ATP certificate to the NRRTS office on or before February 28, 2010.
 - Be awarded NRRTS Registration.

Note: We understand that acquiring the required recommendations for three referral sources may take extra time. As long as the completed Registration application is received before the deadline your application will be considered under the amnesty program.
